

INSTRUCTIONS FOR RECYCLE CONTAINERS

GREY container - Aluminum/Metal Cans:

SERVICE DAY: *First Wednesday of every month.*

(If pick up is missed, they will be picked up on next months assigned collection day, or you may take them to the Landfill, Smith's Food & Drug or Wal-Mart)

Cans should be rinsed and paper labels removed. (No garbage or other materials mixed in the containers)

BLUE container – Newspaper:

SERVICE DAY: *Third Wednesday of every month.*

(If pick up is missed, they will be picked up on next months assigned collection day, or you may take them to the Landfill, Smith's Food & Drug or Wal-Mart)

Newspapers only, no magazines or other paper products. (No garbage or other materials mixed in the containers)

For your information:

Recycle bins are available at Smith's Food & Drug or Wal-Mart for corrugated cardboard, plastic milk jugs (without caps), aluminum cans, and newspapers.

If recycle containers are lost or stolen the property owner will be held responsible and will be billed \$35.00 for each bin on their next solid waste bill.

Your containers need to be brought to the public access road in front of your establishment before 6:00 a.m. on your service day. We understand 6:00 a.m. is early for some people so we highly suggest you place your containers out in front of your establishment the night prior to your service day. If the containers are not out in front of your establishment, it cannot be picked up. Virgin Valley Disposal will not return to service if the containers are not in place prior to 6:00 a.m.

Containers need to be placed in a clear area. The Collection Truck needs to be able to get within ten (10) feet of the container. The containers should be placed away from cars, posts, fences, trees, etc. Those with two (2) containers need to place the containers three (3) feet apart from each other.

If a container is inaccessible to a collection vehicle, it is the owner or occupant's responsibility to move the container to an accessible and approved location for service. Containers that are blocked by vehicles will not be serviced until the next assigned collection day.

Containers need to be on the edge of the street. **(NOT ON THE SIDEWALK OR AGAINST THE CURB).**

All recyclables should be inside the container with the lid closed. Use only the Containers provided. The special truck cannot handle other containers! Please do not set items next to the containers; extra (recyclable) items can be taken to drop-off locations for no extra charge.

You will be able to put more recyclables in the containers if you will smash your cans and unroll your newspapers.

IMPORTANT!!! ARROW ON THE LID OF THE CONTAINER MUST BE POINTING TOWARDS THE STREET.
